The City of Salina and the Salina Parks and Recreation Department is honored to host the 2018 6A Girls State Golf Tournament. The information below is provided to help make this a successful and enjoyable experience for your student-athletes, coaches, and fans.

Tournament Date: October 15th, 2018 - 9am start

Location: Salina Municipal Golf Course– 2500 East Crawford.

Tee-Off: First pairings will start at 9:00am on Holes #1 and #10, with 10 minutes between each pairing.

Practice Round: Please contact the Pro Shop (785-826-7450) or Email Mike Hargrave (mike.hargrave@salina.org) for practice rounds. Practice Rounds will start at **10:30am on Sunday (10/14)**. Cost will be \$15 per person for the practice round. Carts during practice round will be \$15 per rider. (Sunday practice time only).

Range Balls: The cost of range balls will be \$30 a team, or \$5 for Individuals for the day of the tournament.

Coaches Meeting: Will take place Monday morning at 8am in the First Tee of Salina room located on the North end of the Pro Shop. Coffee and Breakfast will be provided.

Markers Meeting: Will take place Sunday afternoon at 6pm in the First Tee of Salina room located on the North end of the Pro Shop. Supper will be provided.

KGA Official: Will be present at this event to help ensure that play is fair and helping with any questions of the State Tournament.

Spectators: Carts will be available to rent for \$40 during tournament play. No Reservations will be taken on carts, as they will be first come first serve on the day of the State Tournament. We have a limited number of carts so please be respectful of other families. Pro Shop will open at 6:30am. Personal Carts may be brought onto course for a \$15 Trail Fee. Carts and spectators must remain on cart path for the duration of the tournament. Please see KSHSAA guidelines for golf spectators at the end of the document.

Lunch: Box lunches will be available for players and coaches. The cost of the meal will be \$8 and can either be paid with a credit card or check on the day of the Tournament. Coaches must pre-order for their team and orders must be received by **Tuesday, October 9th** by 2:00pm to Mike Hargrave at mike.hargrave@salina.org. Coaches will receive complimentary box lunch. Teams are also permitted to have their coolers outside of the clubhouse.

Concessions: Will be available in the Pro Shop for spectators.

Commemorative T-Shirts: Available on site. Athletes and spectators are encouraged to purchase early. Cash or Credit Card only.

Awards: Team and individual awards will take place at the conclusion of regular play and before the playoffs.

Inclement Weather: In the event of inclement weather and tournament postponement, the alternate date is Tuesday, October 16th. We recommend all spectators who purchase a spectator cart to save the receipt.

KSHSAA Spectator Guidelines:

1. Spectators are required to follow golf etiquette at all times. When the player you are watching finishes a hole, remember that the other players in the group may still be finishing.
2. Spectators are asked to stay at least 30 yards behind the group they are watching. However, you need to be aware of the group behind you and not slow them down.
3. Spectators are asked to NOT pick up any golf balls on the course during the tournament. These players are not professionals and the owner of the ball may be several fairways over.
4. Spectators may not offer any advice to any of the players. This includes not offering your suggestions on the club selection, direction of wind, or possible rulings on a situation. If you are 30 yards behind them, this should not be a problem.
5. Spectators may help hunt for a lost ball, but may not be in front of the group to watch where their ball lands. (This is called being a fore caddie).
6. Spectators shall in no instances move a player's bag or ball or offer or provide a ride in a cart during the round of golf. (The player shall be disqualified.)
7. Spectators shall not be involved in the scoring or the recording of scores for the group. The spectators may keep score but cannot correct or dispute the scores of any of the players of the group.
8. Spectators may give encouraging remarks such as "nice shot," "great drive" or "good putt." Please keep all comments positive and at the appropriate times and for all players in the group.
9. Spectators are asked to turn cell phones off when in the vicinity of golfers. Golfers in possession of cell phones during play will be disqualified.
10. The Tournament Manager has the right to forbid spectators entirely if deemed necessary. They also have the right to ask any spectator to leave the course.
