USE LESSONS FROM GEESE



1. By flying in a “V” formation, the whole flock adds 71% flying range.
2. When the lead bird tires, it will rotate back into the formation and receive help from the bird immediately in front.
3. The geese in flying formation honk to encourage those up front to keep up their speed.
