Executive Board Meeting
KSHSAA Board Room
Tuesday, March 19, 2019

The Executive Board met in the office of the Kansas State High School Activities Association on Tuesday, March 19, 2019, with the following in attendance: President Britton Hart, Mike Crouch, Bob Diepenbrock, Tom Flax, Tracey Gros, Shannon Haydock, Deena Horst, Penny Lane, Mark Meyer, Terry Ostmeier, Rudy Perez, Alan Stein and Bill Faflick, Executive Director. Assistant Executive Directors Cheryl Gleason, Francine Martin, Mark Lentz, Jeremy Holaday, Craig Manteuffel, Rod Garman and Office/Operations Manager Brent Unruh were also present.

The Executive Board welcomed Dr. Deena Horst, attending her first meeting following appointment as the representative of the KSBOE and replacing Kathy Busch.

The Minutes of the January 9-10, 2019 meeting were approved.

Items approved by KSHSAA staff on behalf of the Executive Board were reviewed. **A list of these items may be found at the end of these minutes.**

PUBLIC FORUM

None present.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

The Executive Board received reports from Executive Director Bill Faflick and the Assistant Executive Directors regarding the status of programs and services of the Association. The staff reported on the culmination of winter activities and plans for the upcoming spring activity season. The Executive Director gave a financial report.

LIABILITY AND CATASTROPHIC INSURANCE UPDATE

Spencer Fields and Jan Mason of Willis Towers Watson Insurance, met with the Executive Board to provide an update on information pertaining to liability, catastrophic and medical coverage for member schools of the KSHSAA for the 2019-20 school year. It was voted unanimously to purchase coverage through Mutual of Omaha. Information regarding coverage and the premium per student will be mailed to all member school superintendents and principals in May with the annual membership mailing. There are no changes in coverage from last year (\$25K deductible, \$5M lifetime benefit). More specific information regarding coverage and benefits for the 2019-20 school year will be provided in the membership mailing. The premium per student will increase by 22 cents (3.4%) next school year. Member schools will pay **\$6.83 to cover each student (grades 7 – 12) participating in KSHSAA activities**, regardless of the number of activities in which the student participates.

POSTSEASON OFFICIATING FEES

Based on the established three-year rotation, staff presented Executive Board members with historic background on fees presently paid to officials working postseason contests in baseball, softball, volleyball and wrestling. After reviewing the information provided, the following game fees were approved effective with the 2019-20 school year:

WICHITA CENTRAL CHRISTIAN ACADEMY APPROVED FOR MEMBERSHIP STATUS IN 2019-20

As a follow up to the request and presentation in the January meeting by Head of School Michael Hunter and Secondary School Principal/Athletic Director Kenny Waddell, the KSHSAA voted unanimously to approve Wichita Central Christian Academy for KSHSAA membership effective with the 2019-20 school year.

MEMBER SCHOOL DUES APPROVED FOR 2019-2020

The Executive Board voted unanimously to continue member school dues at the current level of \$400 senior high and \$125 middle school/junior high for the 2019-20 school year. KSHSAA membership materials will be mailed in May to building principals and superintendents of all member schools.

MIDDLE/JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL AT-LARGE REPRESENTATIVE APPOINTED TO BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Per **Bylaw, Article IV, Section 5**, the Executive Board appointed Principal Brandon Simmelink, McPherson Middle School, to a two-year at-large term on the Board of Directors (2019-2021).

SANTA FE TRAIL LEAGUE REPRESENTATIVE

With the Santa Fe Trail League adding a fourth school as an additional member, they are once again eligible for representation on the KSHSAA Board of Directors.

PRIVATE SCHOOL UPDATE

As a next step following discussion and request of the Executive Board at the January 9-10, 2019 meeting, the Executive Board received a report and plan to address concerns expressed by members of the Frontier League. The board received a summary of discussion of member private school leadership teams expressed during a meeting on February 27, 2019. The focus moving forward is to increase transparency and education regarding this issue. This is inclusive of rules review, meeting with leagues, partnership with educational entity for in-depth study, and continued communication/education with stakeholders.

TENNIS REGIONALS

The executive board approved regional tennis tournaments with eight (8) or fewer teams to conduct one day competitions, regardless of the number of teams in the classification.

COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT APPROVED

Per **Rule 29-2-1(a)3**, the Executive Board voted unanimously to approve a cooperative agreement between Sedan, Howard-West Elk, and Burden-Central for boys golf for the spring 2019 season.

SUMMER MORATORIUM

The Executive Board approved the following interpretations for the summer moratorium scheduled for July 1-7, 2019; during this time:

COACHES MAY take a vacation.

COACHES MAY coach their child on an individual basis.

SCHOOL COACHES MAY NOT work with middle/high school (7-12) students during this time frame.

COACHES MAY NOT SWAP TEAMS with another school coach (boys/girls, other school team). A coach from another school cannot coach your school team. Coaches from another sport entirely cannot coach another sport's team.

NO SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION is permitted including the school coach providing personal transportation to students from their school team.

SCHOOL FACILITIES MUST be closed to any school coach and students. *EXCEPTION (SEE BELOW)*

STUDENTS MAY BE PERMITTED to participate in events/competitions at a school facility if an outside agency/group/organization leases the facility for competition and organizes the event.

STUDENTS MAY compete during this time but they cannot be coached by a school coach.

NO team camps.

ACTIVITY TESTING AND RULES MEETING ACCOUNTABILITY FOR COACHES

The Executive Board discussed the expectations and accountability for head coaches to attend a rules meeting and to successfully complete a rules test for their respective activity. The discussion included expansion of the KSHSAA portal to include assistant coach rosters and learning expectations. The board tabled any decision until the April meeting.

INDEPENDENT DEBATE PARTICIPATION

The Executive Board received an update on the increasing number of independent debate opportunities following the state championship and the impact on Kansas students and schools.

6-PLAYER FOOTBALL DISCUSSION

The Executive Board received a report and engaged in discussion regarding the history of 6-player football and deliberated regarding the potential growth of the 6-player format.

BOARD OF DIRECTOR MEETING

Following a preview of the proposed KSHSAA Board of Directors agenda, to the large number of items on the April Board of Directors agenda, the start time for the meeting was advanced one hour and will begin at **3:00 p.m.** on April 26, 2019 at the KSHSAA office.
